

The mission of Bridge The Gaps (BTG) is to assist underprivileged, lower-income, minority, and at-risk students by reconnecting their cultural, emotional, mental, and educational gaps.

Our Vision is to utilize athletics to reconnect students with education and teach them to be successful at home, in the classroom, in the community, and in life after sports.

BTG believes all students should have access to the resources they need for mental, social, and physical wellness required to live healthy lives.

# **REAL TALK 4REAL**

BAMM

Real Talk 4Real is an outreach program that discusses real-life scenarios and their consequences. Onsite workshops will deconstruct various viral social media posts depicting violence, domestic violence, and bullying and have discussions about the real-life consequences associated with those actions. Sessions will also listen to various songs that speak to acts of violence, drugs, and a street lifestyle, deconstruct those lyrics and attaching real-life consequences to those actions.

The Behavior Attitude Mental Mentoring (BAMM) program targets at risk students who may be faced with personal and or mental hardships that can reflect on their ability to perform or learn in the classroom. When a student is under immense pressures or in an environment of fear, anxiety, frustration, or confusion it is reflective on their ability to learn. The onsite BAMM program has assisted and influenced students while encouraging the benefits of youth engagement to help create balance, mental health, and encompass a positive learning experience.

## **PLAY 4 PURPOSE**

Bridge The Gaps assists at-risk, athletic students who have shown an active interest and role in society through their passions in various athletic activities. Our Play 4 Purpose program helps empower students to utilize their interests and talents in sports to obtain a higher education. Play 4 Purpose provides resources, educational tools, and helps with ancillary expenses that are not covered for most underprivileged education facilities.

#### MISSION

To seek, educate, and empower young men and women to become champions in their lives and their community by avoiding the pitfalls of destructive thinking and negative choices.

#### **ONSITE WORKSHOPS**

Omar "Coach D" Durham and Terrence "Coach Tee" Sampson will facilitate an interactive two-part onsite workshop at high-risk public schools that consists of a 90-minute deconstruction of a violent viral video or song lyrics followed by a one-hour victim impact statement from a victim of violent crimes.

The workshops will be recorded for various social media channels and posts to further educate the public at large. As a Real Life 4Real Partner, your donation will directly help build awareness in our target market in relation to understanding actual consequences of violence on any level, whether domestic violence, assaults or homicides. The goal is for our children to view violent events from the perspective of the victim, victim's family, and the community at large, causing a deterrent for them after realizing the far-reaching consequences of violent acts.



The BAMM program provides students with resources and mentorship to help foster mental health and attitude balancing to encompass a positive learning approach and environment.

#### RESOURCES

Student mental health is being neglected. Most public-school campuses are stretched too thin on resources to rethink their approach in helping students with behavior and/or learning challenges. In most cases, these students are left behind to navigate emotional challenges on their own, resulting in class disruption.





#### MISSION

The mission of our Education Program is to make ancillary tutoring and learning resources available for <u>all</u> students.

#### RESOURCES

Our education program support students with resource needs specific to educational opportunities and supplemental college coaching. Most public education systems are not preparing young students for the skills required for college acceptance.

# **PROGRAMS IN ACTION**

#### **REAL TALK 4REAL**

Bridge The Gaps has hosted and scheduled workshops at Bammel Middle School, Dekaney High School, Spring High School, and Westfield High School targeting high-risk young men identified by the teaching staff. The 90-minute workshops have opened discussions with students, encouraging communications with the young men around their decisions, and avoiding violence. At Bammell Middle School, the administration has reported <u>improved student behavior</u>, and a direct impact on <u>reduced fights</u> with growing interest for participation from other students. At all High Schools administration has reported <u>improved grades</u>, and <u>a reduction in overall school fights</u>.

#### BAMM

The BAMM program has directly influenced the following public schools:

- Bammell Middle School <u>Becoming a Man</u> interactive lectures directly impact high-risk students identified by administration. Interactive lectures take place every Wednesday, for 2 class periods, <u>reaching approximately 45 students</u>. This program has a waiting list for its next series.
- Dekaney High School Bridge The Gaps has provided direct murder/death outreach and counseling, and individual student mental mentorship, resulting in improved grades and improved attendance. This program is <u>scheduled to grow</u> to Klein Forrest High School next semester.

#### PLAY 4 PURPOSE

Bridge The Gaps was able to help launch the <u>Dekaney High School boys and girls golf team</u>. This initiative included providing equipment for all students who were new to golf, and training resources from PGA Golf Pro, Steve Williams. This program was launched in 2020 and now has tripled in sized exposing a new sport to the student body, <u>resulting in improved grades and student attendance</u>. The Play 4 Purpose program has also provided resources for <u>KFA 7v7</u> for uniforms, tournament fees, travel, and ancillary training resources to help underprivilidged students remain competitive in the student-athlete market. Bridge The Gaps has also partnered with <u>Pound4Pound Boxing</u> providing free classes, directly impacting their <u>confidence</u> and helping to deter <u>student bullying</u>.

#### **BTG FAMILES**

Bridge The Gaps Families has hosted <u>multiple food drives</u> in conjunction with the student-body at numerous high schools specifically around the holidays. Food drives provide <u>full meals</u> to include a ham or turkey, for our lower-income families. In 2022 BTG also encountered multiple families who were directly impacted by an apartment fire. BTG was able to help provide necessities to help these families <u>recover from total losses</u>. Our Families program has directly <u>provided higher quality learning</u> environments for our at-risk students.


Bridge The Gaps (BTG) Education (EDU) has directly provided <u>in-home tutoring</u> <u>for multiple students</u> in need with an <u>increase of 40% projected for 2023</u>. The BTG EDU program also hosted back-to-school drives providing backpacks filled with supplies for elementary, middle, and high school students in lower-income communities in the Spring Independent School District.









